

As we take stock of this campaign's success, I am proud to see our collective vision of inclusive, transparent governance coming to life in every corner of Tripura.




This booklet serves not only as a record of our accomplishments but also as an inspiration for continued participation in the ongoing journey of community empowerment and sustainable development.






India is primarily a rural country, with about 70% of its population residing in villages. Therefore, the overall socio-economic development of India largely depends on rural progress. National development can be achieved only through the comprehensive development of both urban and rural areas. Mahatma Gandhi believed that India's holistic development could only be realized when rural progress was assured. He advocated for "Gram Swaraj" (village self-rule), emphasizing administrative and financial independence for village panchayats as mentioned in Article 40 of the Indian Constitution, allowing them to identify and address local issues independently through effective planning and implementation.

Post-independence, several committees were formed to empower the Panchayat system, notable among them being the Ashok Mehta Committee, Balwant Rai Mehta Committee, L.M. Singhvi Committee, and G.V.K. Rao Committee. Based on their recommendations, the 73rd Constitutional Amendment was passed in 1992 and came into effect on April 24, 1993, now celebrated as National Panchayati Raj Day. This amendment introduced a three-tier Panchayat system comprising the Gram Panchayat, Panchayat Samiti, and Zilla Parishad. It established provisions for direct elections, empowerment of panchayats, reservation for women and marginalized communities, and the formation of a State Finance Commission, among others. One of the amendment's most notable features was the creation of the Gram Sabha under Article 243 (B).






The Gram Sabha comprises all village voters and is responsible for formulating and approving plans for rural socio-economic development. It serves as a platform for villagers to voice their concerns to the Panchayat, contributing equally to problem-solving measures. The Gram Sabha strengthens democratic participation and decentralization. No Panchayat decisions can be implemented without the Gram Sabha's consent, ensuring community involvement in developmental initiatives. The previous year's financial report is presented during the annual Gram Sabha, promoting transparency and accountability in local governance.

In Tripura, alongside the Gram Sabha, the Tripura Panchayat Act 1993 mandates the formation of the Gram Sansad to extend grassroots-level community participation further. The Gram Sansad exclusively determines beneficiaries of government schemes, including employment initiatives.

Following the guidelines of the Union Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Tripura mandates that every Panchayat holds Women's and Children's Assemblies, thereby promoting women's empowerment, children's rights, protection, and overall development.

The Gram Sabha is a constitutional right. When every individual is given the right to speak in the Gram Sabha or Sansad, when issues raised by the people are addressed through public discussion, and when every woman and child is given the platform to express their concerns, a Panchayat can be fully developed. Broad community participation is the cornerstone of development, achievable only through a strong Gram Sabha.






The primary purpose of this booklet is to function as both an educational tool and a practical guide. The objectives are as follows:

- Raising Awareness and Knowledge: Many citizens are unaware of the full scope of Gram Sabha's powers and responsibilities. This booklet aims to educate villagers, local leaders, and stakeholders on the rights, functions, and processes associated with a Vibrant Gram Sabha.
- **Promoting Democratic Participation:** A key characteristic of a Vibrant Gram Sabha is the engagement of all community members, particularly marginalized groups such as women, children, and disadvantaged castes or tribes. This booklet is a living example of such participation.
- Guiding Effective Meeting Practices: To achieve its potential, the Gram Sabha must function efficiently, addressing local issues and approving development plans transparently. The booklet visualizes effective meetings, facilitating open dialogue, and ensuring that decisions reflect the community's collective will.
- Empowering Local Governance Structures: An empowered Gram Sabha is essential for responsive local governance. By providing a clear framework on how communities can advocate for their needs, allocate resources, and manage projects, the booklet shows how they come together and perform..
- Fostering Transparency and Accountability: A central aspect of a Vibrant Gram Sabha is transparency in local administration. The booklet would underscore the Gram Sabha's role in practical oversight and project evaluation, empowering citizens to see what is happening.


STRATEGY FOR THE PROGRAMME



The Rural Development (Panchayat) Department has formulated a detailed strategy for the conduct of a "Vibrant Gram Sabha" on October 2, 2024, to coincide with the launch of the People's Plan Campaign (PPC). This event will initiate the preparation of the Panchayat Development Plan (PDP) for the fiscal year 2025-26. The strategy aims to guide Block Development Officers (BDOs) and other relevant officials to ensure smooth and effective execution. The strategy is outlined as follows:

- 1. **Engagement of Senior Citizens**; Objective: To honor senior citizens (aged 75 and above) by inviting them to share their experiences, achievements, and vision for the Gram Panchayat (GP). Action Points:
 - BDOs shall identify and issue formal invitations to senior citizens aged 75 and above.
 - Selected senior citizens should be oriented on topics of discussion, which will include the GP's achievements, existing gaps, and future aspirations.
 - Ensure the active participation of senior citizens by providing suitable seating arrangements at the event.
- 2. **Venue Selection and Setup**; Objective: To provide an organized and welcoming event environment. Action Points:
 - Prioritize the use of a community hall for the event; if unavailable, establish an outdoor venue with sufficient tenting, seating, lighting, and a sound system.
 - Arrange for refreshments to be available for all attendees.
 - Decorate the venue appropriately and distribute informative leaflets about the PPC to enhance attendee awareness.
- 3. **Involvement of Eminent Personalities**; Objective: To inspire community members through the presence of distinguished local leaders. Action Points:
 - Extend an invitation to the honorable MLA or another respected figure within the community.
 - Arrange for a recorded video message from the invited dignitary to be played during the event.
 - Equip the venue with a laptop, projector, and sound system to facilitate the seamless display of the video message.

STRATEGY FOR THE PROGRAMME



4. Personal Testimonies from Local Residents

Objective: Encourage reflection on GP history, growth, and personal experiences. Action Points:

- Identify one male and one female resident to share insights into the Gram Panchayat's social and physical landscape, recount their personal life stories, and discuss the evolution of the Panchayat system.
- Offer structured guidance on key topics, such as notable changes in infrastructure, community relations, and personal anecdotes that highlight the GP's journey over the years.

5. Tree Plantation Campaign (1 Ped Maa Ke Naam)

Objective: Symbolize growth and honor community leaders through the act of tree planting.

Action Points:

- Coordinate the planting of at least 75 trees, prioritizing fruit-bearing varieties to benefit the community.
- Invite distinguished guests to participate by planting a tree in their name, fostering a sense of belonging and stewardship.

6. Pledges for Community Goals

Objective: Reinforce collective commitments to significant community values. Action Points:


- Facilitate the administration of the following pledges for all attendees:
 - Swachhata Pledge (Cleanliness)
 - Anti-Drug Abuse Pledge
 - o Fit India Pledge
 - o GPDP Pledge (Development Goals)
 - o LSDG Theme Pledge: "Ek Tripura, Sreshtha Tripura"
 - Youth Pledge to uphold the vision and values of their elders.

7. Action-Oriented Community Program

Objective: Foster active community participation through meaningful initiatives. Action Points:

• Implement a community-driven event such as a cleanliness campaign or a blood donation camp, coordinated with the support of the Health Department

8. Publicity and Outreach

Objective: Enhance awareness and maximize attendance for the event.

Action Points:

- Publicize the Gram Sabha through various channels, including public announcements (miking), distribution of leaflets, personalized household letters, and strategic use of social media platforms.
- Ensure the distribution of a PPC (Public Participation Communication) leaflet to all attendees to reinforce key messages and engagement.

9. Health Screening Desk

Objective: Address the health needs and concerns of the community.

Action Points:

- Collaborate with the Health Department to establish a dedicated health screening desk at the event.
- Provide essential health services such as cataract screenings, blood pressure monitoring, and blood typing.

10. SHG Products Stall

Objective: Promote and support local entrepreneurship.

Action Points:

• Set up a stall dedicated to Self-Help Groups (SHGs) to showcase and sell their products, thereby fostering local business initiatives and cultivating community pride.

11. Success Stories Video Display

Objective: Motivate participants by sharing community achievements.

Action Points:

 Arrange an LED screen to display curated videos that highlight local success stories, sourced from the official website of the RD Department and other credible sources.

12. Photo Exhibition of Developmental Work

Objective: Visually emphasize past developmental achievements.

Action Points:

• Organize an exhibition featuring a minimum of 10 A3-sized photographs accompanied by concise descriptions in Bengali, English, and Kokborok, showcasing significant projects completed in the previous year.





13. Presentation of Action Plan for Bal Sabha and Mahila Sabha

Objective: To apprise the community of initiatives focused on youth and women. Action Points:

• Present a comprehensive action plan to conduct the Bal Sabha (Children's Assembly) and Mahila Sabha (Women's Assembly) within the framework of the People's Participation and Collaboration (PPC) initiative.

14. Documentation and Reporting

Objective: To ensure accurate recording and reporting of the Gram Sabha proceedings. Action Points:

- Document the event through photographs, videos, and a detailed written summary.
- Upload event details onto the designated online meeting portal and the Panchayat Nirnay App.
- Prepare a concise 2-3 minute video summary and submit it to the Directorate within 15 days of the event.

15. Concluding Ceremony

Objective: To foster national pride and strengthen community bonds. Action Points:

- Conclude the Gram Sabha with the rendition of the National Anthem.
- Distribute refreshments and informational leaflets on PPC to the attendees.

16. Strategic Social Audit

Objective: To organize periodic social audits so that checks, balances & accountability can be maintained

Action Points:

- Organize proper social audits quarterly
- Publish periodic reports with proper photographs




Bamutia RD Block




Jirania RD Block



- This Special Gram Sabha exemplified Rupaichari Block's dedication to fostering a united, sustainable community.



This involves policy reforms, capacity-building initiatives, social inclusivity strategies, and awareness-raising efforts. The following are key pathways to achieve popular participation in Gram Sabhas:


- Awareness and Education Campaigns: Effective awareness programs tailored to rural communities are essential to inform villagers of their rights and the importance of their participation in Gram Sabha meetings. These campaigns should utilize local languages and culturally relevant materials to enhance understanding and engagement. NGOs, local government agencies, and Panchayats can collaborate to organize workshops, public meetings, and informational sessions that empower communities with knowledge.
- Capacity Building for Local Leaders and Members: Training programs aimed at enhancing the skills of Gram Panchayat members and local leaders can significantly improve the quality of Gram Sabha meetings. Capacity-building efforts should cover topics like leadership, conflict resolution, transparent governance, and inclusive planning. Equipping leaders with these skills can foster a more organized and effective Gram Sabha, encouraging community members to participate confidently.
- **Promotion of Inclusive Participation:** To ensure participation from all demographic segments—including women, marginalized groups, and youth—the Gram Sabha must be accessible and welcoming. Introducing separate forums or sessions for women (Mahila Sabha) and children (Bal Sabha) can help these groups voice their concerns more freely. Additionally, establishing quotas for marginalized communities and youth representation can further support inclusivity and ensure all voices are considered in local decision-making.





- Leveraging Digital and Social Media: Using digital platforms to share meeting schedules, agendas, and outcomes can help increase visibility and interest among community members. Where internet access is limited, mobile phone-based messaging or community radio broadcasts can disseminate this information effectively. Digital tools can also streamline data collection, feedback, and record-keeping, making the Gram Sabha more transparent and accessible.
- Institutionalizing Feedback Mechanisms: Establishing regular feedback mechanisms allows community members to voice their opinions on Gram Sabha decisions and ongoing projects. Through suggestion boxes, surveys, or periodic review meetings, citizens can express concerns, share ideas, and assess the progress of development initiatives. This interactive approach enhances trust and accountability, motivating more people to engage in Gram Sabha proceedings.
- Improving Meeting Accessibility and Transparency: Ensuring that Gram Sabha meetings are held at convenient times, in accessible locations, and with transparent agendas can foster greater attendance. Providing meeting summaries, budgets, and decisions in publicly accessible formats (e.g., notice boards, local newsletters) further promotes transparency.
